# Smokey Mountain



**Location:** Manila, Philippines

**Since:** 1954 (still ongoing)

**Description:** a massive garbage dump and surrounding slum area

**Origin of the name:** constant smoke from garbage fires  
→ "Smokey Mountain"

**Peak Population:** about 21,000 people (1990)

**Livelihood:** collecting and selling recyclable materials from garbage

**1995:** government enforced evacuation

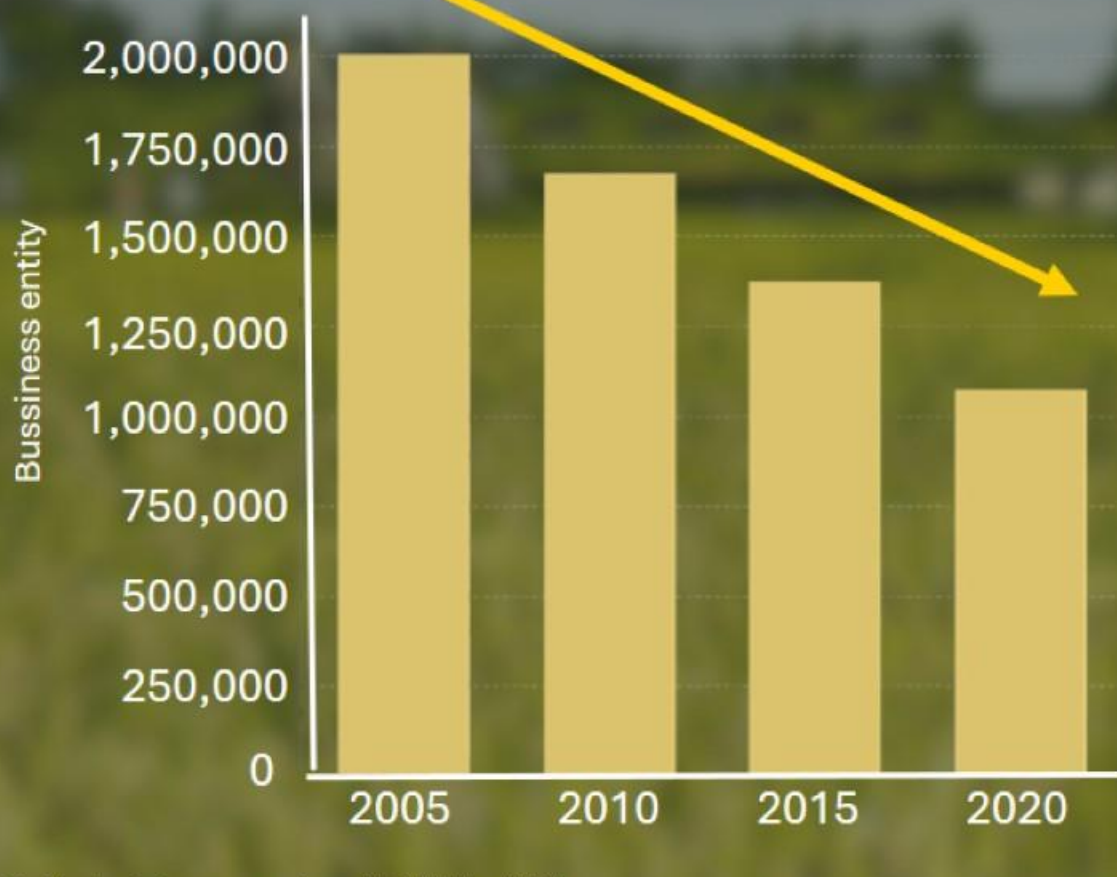

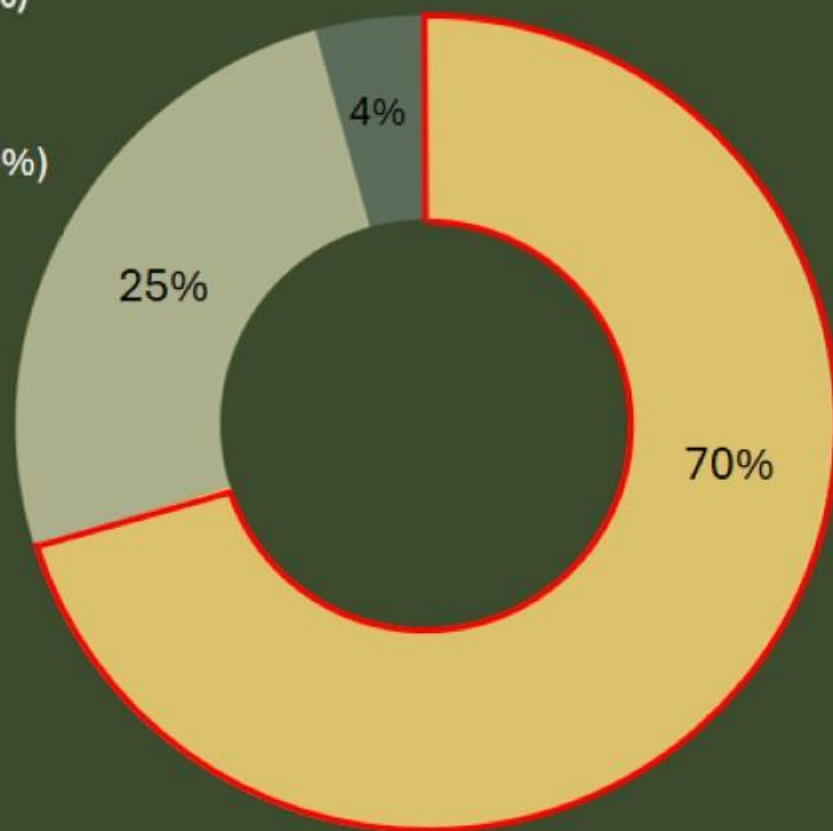

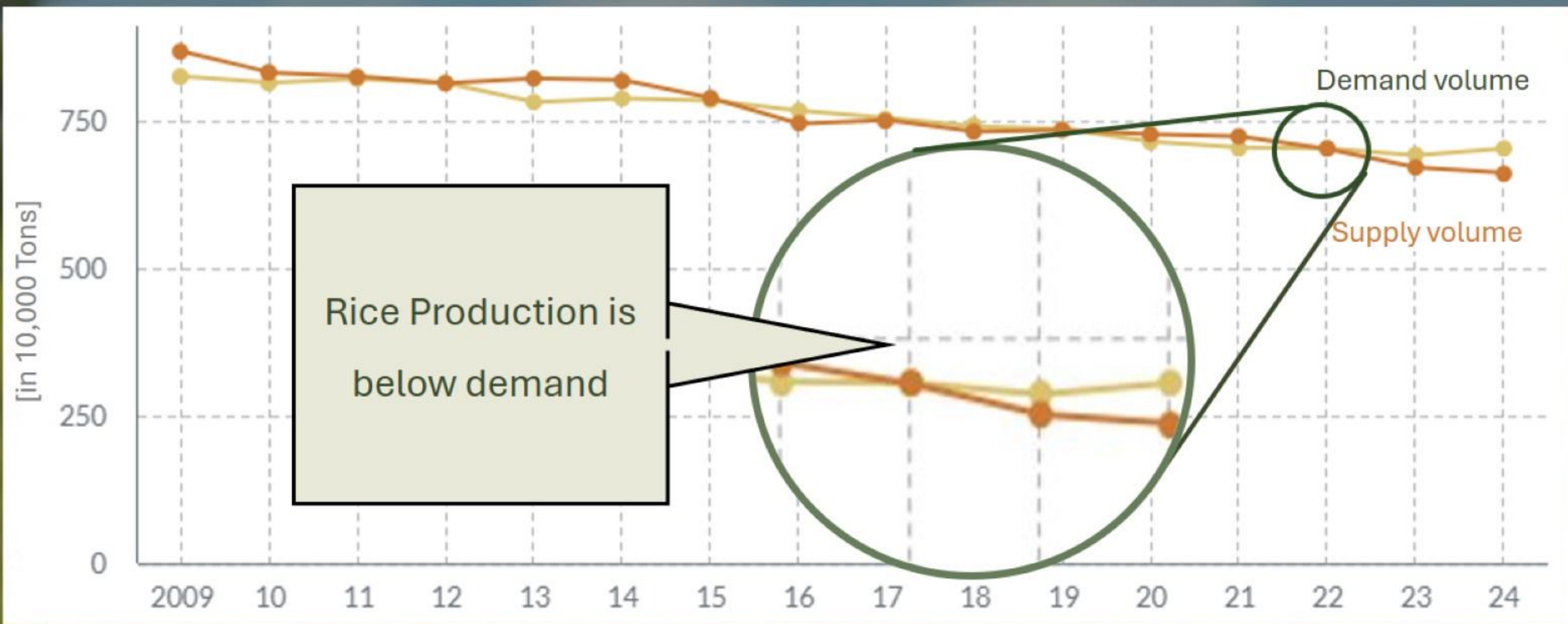

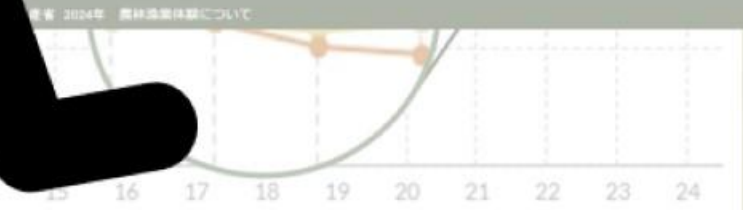

# What is Asian Development Bank?

Established in 1966

68 countries are member (Japan and the U.S. are the major investing countries)

Purpose: Support for economic growth and social development in Asia Pacific

Field of activity: Infrastructure development, poverty reduction, climate change action

Vision: Realizing “free of poverty in Asia-Pacific”



# ADB's Financial Inclusion Support Project in the Philippines

Purpose: To maintain the environment which low income group and local people can access financial service in the philippines

Background: Almost 50% of philipino adults do not have bank account

## Initiatives:

1. Use degital technology-To spread degital payment and online banking system. To maintain financial infrastructure.
2. Improvements of policy and regulations- To construct the financing structure to the small business and individuals
3. promotion of females' economic participation-improve gender equality and strengthen regional economic

# ADB's employment support activity in Bhutan

ADB launched job creation program, is collaborated with the Bhutanese Government to deal with the problem of employment issues in Buhtan, where unemployment has reached 30% due to Covid-19.

## Major initiatives

Vocational training in degital section: To provide new skills to young people and promote new employment

Improve the image of vocational training: To develop measures to improve social reputation and salary attractiveness.

# Smokey Mountain



# What is Smokey Mountain?

Location: Tondo, Manila

## History

1954: Became a dumping ground for rubbish from Manila city, and rapidly became a slum where the poor settled

late-1980s: the government decided to close the mountain because of bad impression

1995: Residents were allocated public housing and forced to leave. However, some are still live there

## Negative cycle

live in the dump site and collect and sell junk items

cause poverty because of lack of access for education and healthcare



residents' health and finance are unstable

# What is Tahanang Walang Hagdanan (TWH)?

Tahanang Walang Hagdanan is NGO which support PwD in the philippines, means “house with no step”

Facilities are designed to be user-friendly for PwD and provide a safe environment for wheelchair users.

TWH was established in 1973

Purpose: To improve the lives of PwD and they can live independently and with dignity in society.

Field of activity: provide employment opportunity, vocational training, educational and medical assistance


It supports other PwD with the benefits that disabled people gained from work

### 1. Use

**Smartphones** as a platform that allows students to take classes wherever they are, as long as they have a smartphone, by distributing videos and correspondence-type classes.



### 2. Provide school meals

If students going to school for getting school lunches, children who are forced to work will be allowed by their parents to go to school because they will be able to float one meal, and they will be able to receive an education.



### 3. Improve the Quality of Teachers

By improving the quality of teachers, children will be able to experience the joy of learning for themselves. Conduct interactive classes so that students do not feel bored.

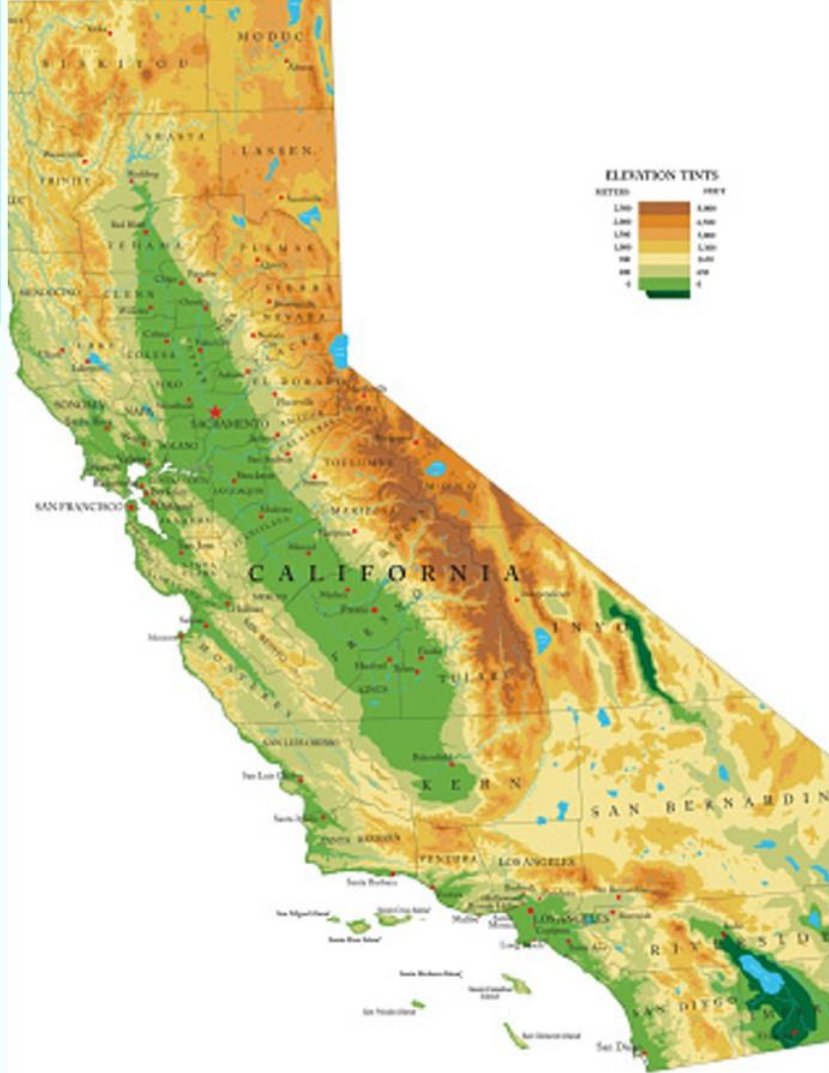

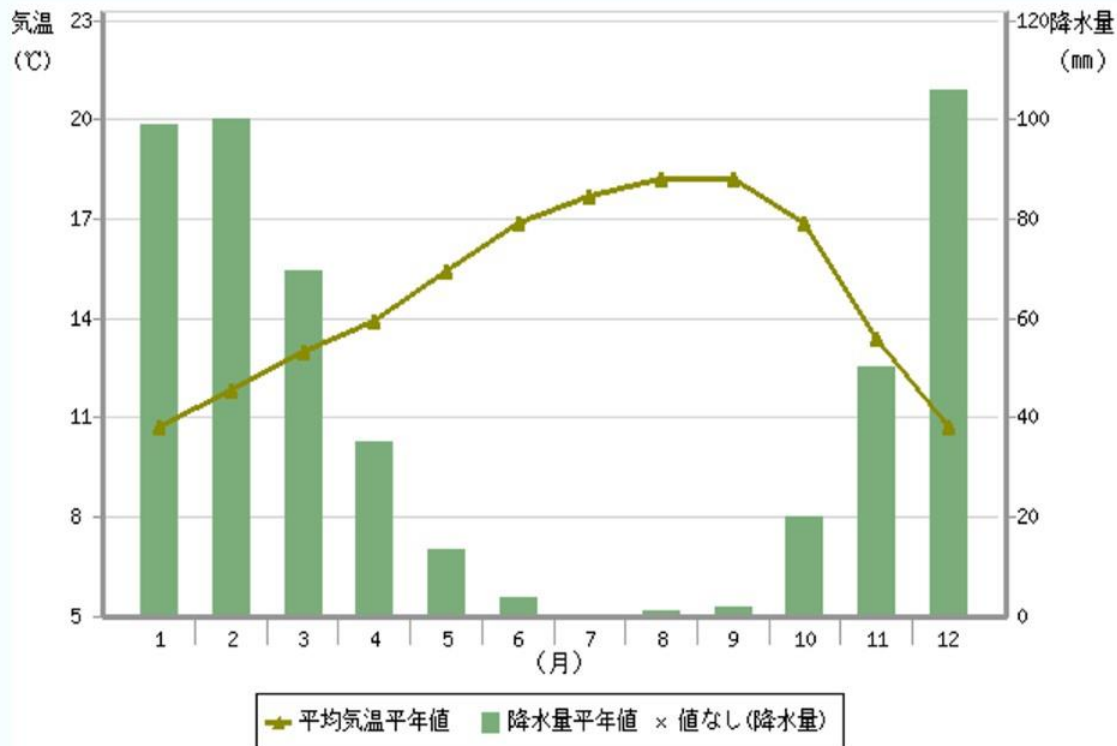
# The Terrain of California



① California is surrounded by the Pacific Ocean to the west and the Sierra Nevada Mountains to the east, forming a vast agricultural region (Central Valley) centered on a vast and fertile basin.

② California's farmland and pastureland cover approximately 9.79 million hectares, nearly twice the size of Japan's total arable land.

# The Climate of California

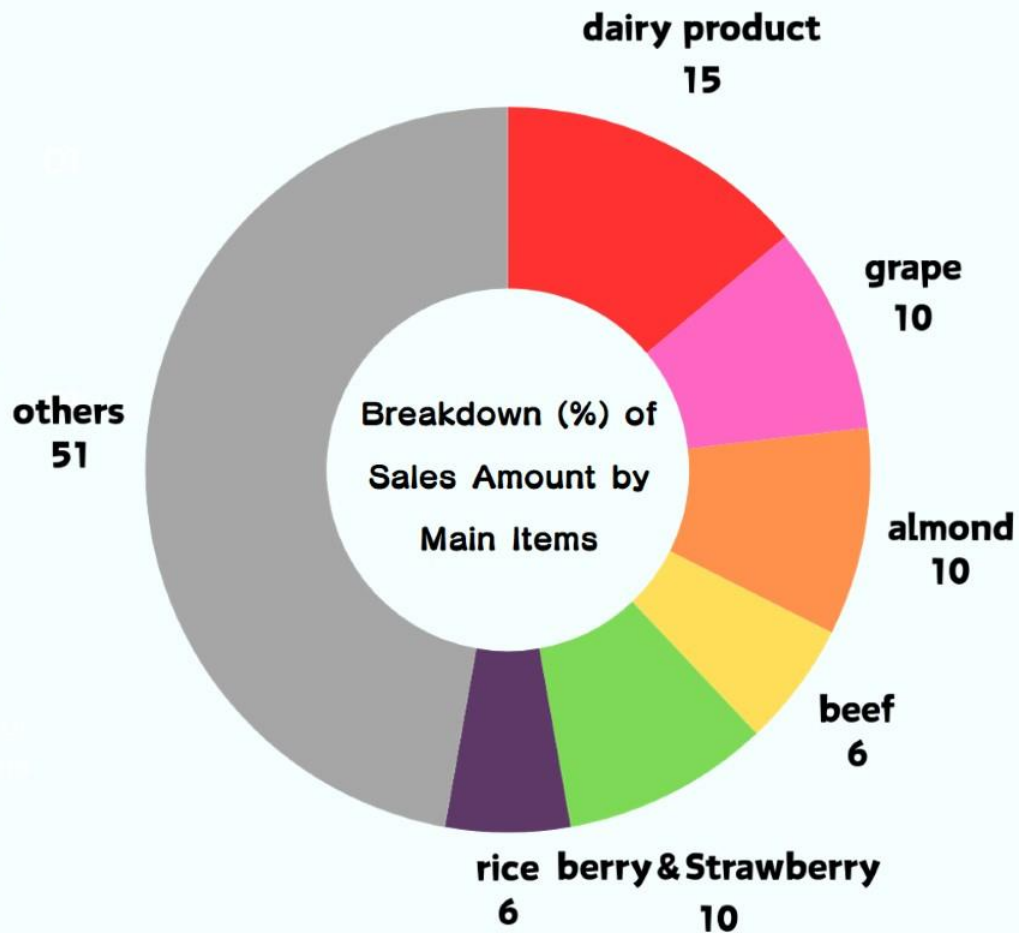


**Most of California has a Mediterranean climate, characterized by dry, warm summers and mild, rainy winters.**

# Agriculture and Livestock Data of California.

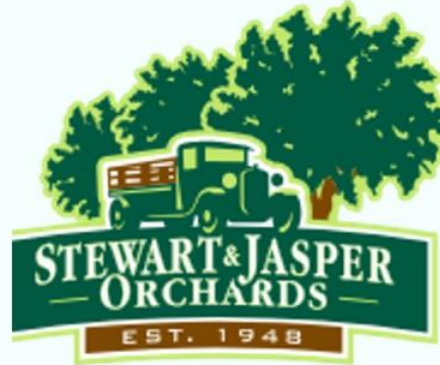
The value of agricultural product sales in California was \$51.1 billion (as of 2021), making it the top state in the U.S. for over 50 years.

California is said to produce over 400 types of agricultural products, with dairy products, nuts, and fruits being particularly prominent.



# Modesto, the birthplace of almond production.

In fact, Modesto, where we was fortunate enough to stay during school exchanges and homestays, is home to the headquarters of the California Almond Association. Modesto is also a central hub for almond production in the United States!



**Modesto is also actively involved in dairy farming and livestock production, with the entire region contributing to these industries.**

**Modesto Junior College (MJC), which we visited, was established to serve the local community. The college focuses on research in dairy farming and livestock at the West Campus, and horticulture at the East Campus. Interestingly, MJC is also the alma mater of George Lucas.**



# **Organizing the issues of Japanese agriculture in comparison with the United States.**

- I . Small farmland area (problem of abandoned farmland).**
- II . Lack of successors among agricultural workers.**
- III . Weakening of communities related to agriculture and livestock farming.**

# Current State of Agriculture in Japan.

Japan has a rich climate, with distinct seasons, but agriculture is heavily influenced by weather conditions, which introduces a gamble-like element.

- The small size of farmland per farmer results in low harvest yields, making automation difficult.
- There is a decline in the number of agricultural workers.



# Reasons for the Decline in Agricultural Workers in Japan.

In Japan, the lack of successors for farmers due to the aging of the population is a major problem. The main reason for the aging of Japanese farmers is that there are high barriers for young people to enter agriculture. In general, farming is characterized by fluctuating income and physically demanding work.



# Trends in the Number of Agricultural Workers in Japan

In the year 2000, the number of agricultural workers was 2.4 million, but by 2023, it had decreased to 1.16 million, showing a declining trend.

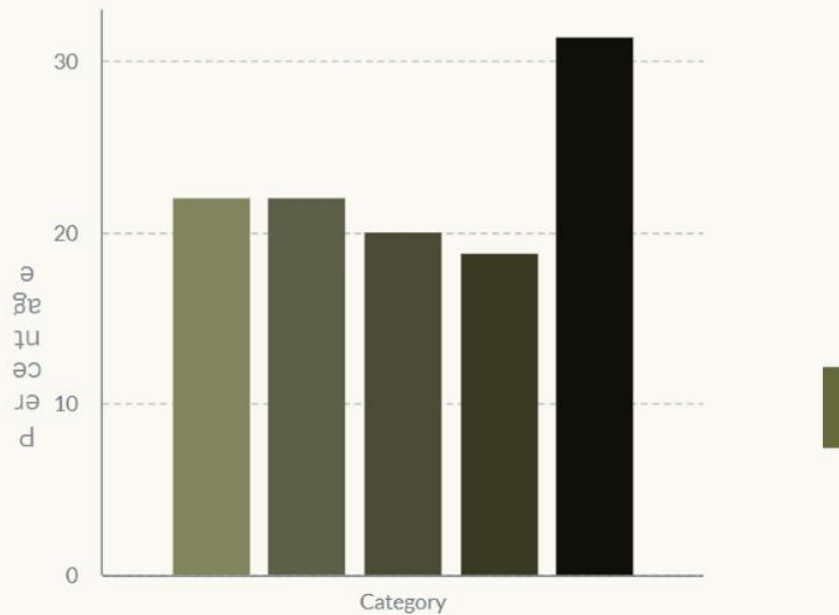

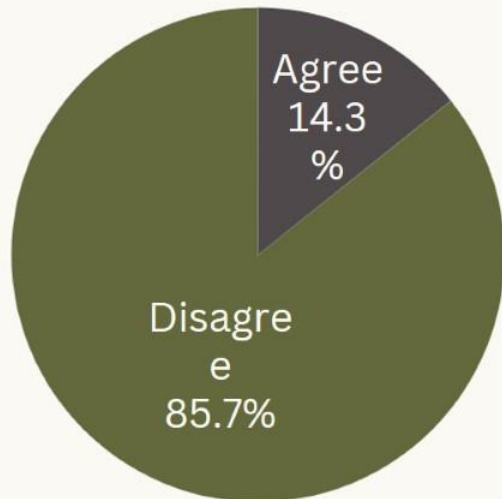

Do you agree or disagree with feeling that cultural properties are something that is approachable or familiar?



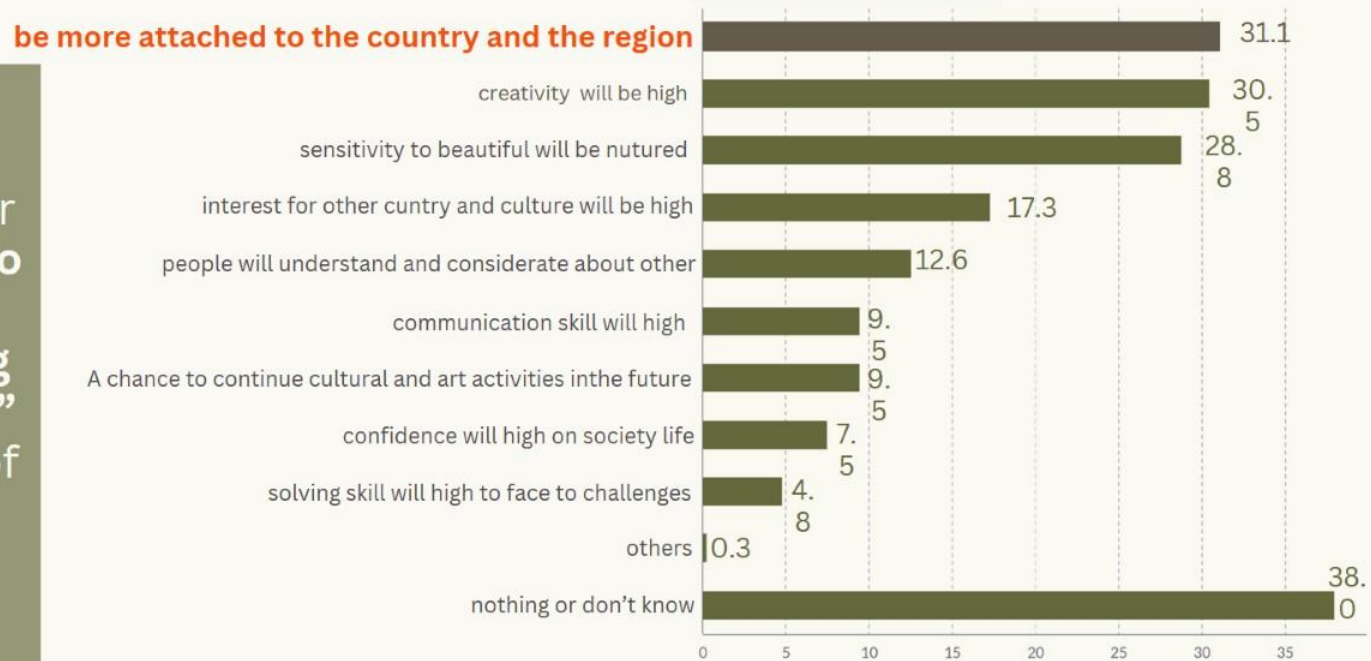

People who feel cultural properties as something that is approachable or familiar were only 14.3% in total.

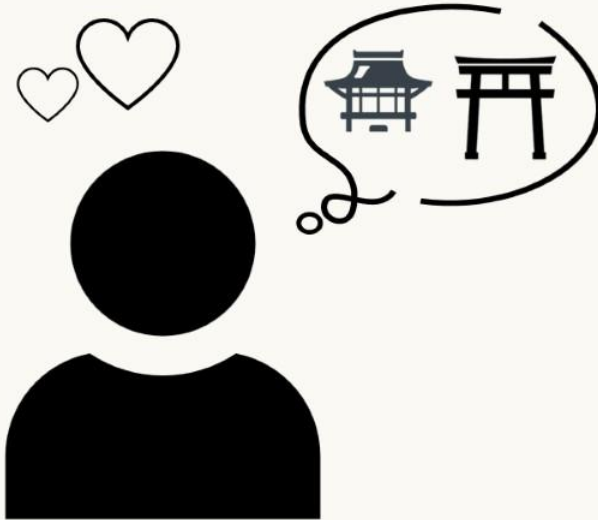


# Expected effect of “Culture and art experience”
